Asking for and viewing information is free. You can only be charged for tott**t**ion is free. After you ask for information, the agency should:

- Confirm receipt of request in writing
- Check if it holds the information; if not, transfer request to correct agency
 - Provide you with either:
 - the requested information,
 - •

You have the right to an internal review if you receive:

- no answer within the time period
- a denial of information
- only part of the information
- a transfer notice with which you disagree
- a fee/charge you think is too high
- or other negative decision

During an internal review, a senior official or internal review body will look at your appeal and give you a decision in writing within thirty (30) working days.
