Atlanta PAD was born out of the work and vision of Atlantans directly impacted restand incarceration Since 2017, Atlanta PAD has provided critical services to local government and residents that reduce the reliance on the criminal justice system while developing a model for specialized community response that has received national recognition. Atlantar ovides all Atlanta, Metro Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority (MARTA), and Georgetate and ech Police the option to divert such persons away frigail and towards the care and support that they need. Additionally, Atlanta PAD partnerswith the City of Atlanta's 311(ATL311) nonemergency services line to dispatch response teams to community concerns, making Atlanta the first city in the country to dispatch imperson response services through 33 dervices include immediate shelter, basic supplies and care, outreach, and case management. For 2022, Atlanta PAD accepted 369 diversions (331 of which were optest diversions) and 1,321 community response requests through 311
